- Quantification and reduction of harmful substances
- White water contamination, treatment and abatement of contamination
- Process technology developments: materials handling, pulping, screening, cleaning, flotation and dispersion
- Recycle plant optimization
- Environmental impacts including sludge utilization, land filling, and water management
- Utilization of recycling process reject
- On-line control tools
- Lessons learned and best practices in new recycle facilities
- New technology and products
